

Congratulations on becoming a Registered Student Organization (RSO) at Michigan Tech! Please read through the following information on the privileges and responsibilities that come with RSO status.

- 1. You are required to keep your <u>Involvement Link</u> updated as this is the official record of your organization's membership and officers.
  - a. Any officer has administrative access to your organization's page.
    - i. A student is only considered a member of the organization if their name is on the roster.
  - b. Involvement Link is utilized to communicate important messages. The organization must have a designated President, Vice President, Secretary, & Treasurer.

- 2. Registered Student Organizations are expected to follow all University Policies related to Registered Student Organizations:
  - a. Mandatory Yearly Re-Registration & Officer Training
  - b. Board of Trustees Policy Chapter 7, Section 7.5
  - c. Officer GPA Requirements
  - d. The RSO Travel Policy
  - e. All other policies pertaining to RSO's and their operations.
- 3. Your organization will be assigned a mailbox in MUB 106.
  - a. Mailboxes are used for important communications to organizations and must be checked at least once per week, when campus is open, by one of your members.
  - b. Your RSO should use the mailing address listed below for all organization mail.
